

## **Wireless Internet Access (Wi-Fi)**

Some Tulsa City-County Library locations offer wireless internet access (“wi-fi”) to users who have a device (laptop, notebook, Mac, PDA, cell phone) that is 802.11 (a, b, or G) compatible.

The service is free and available during the hours the library is open. Other than keeping the service itself up and running, the library cannot offer any technical support for user hardware or connection settings. The library cannot guarantee that your device will be able to connect to our wireless service.

The library’s wireless access – like most public “hot spots” – is not secure. Cautious and informed users should not transmit any personal information – like credit card numbers, passwords, or other sensitive data – while using this service. In addition, the library recommends that users have up-to-date virus and spam protection on their devices. The library is not responsible for any compromised information or hardware/software damage due to security issues.

Users will need to operate on battery power as library outlets are not available for use with this service.

This wireless access is available in as much of a building as possible, but users may encounter “dead” spots where wireless reception is unavailable or limited.

There is no access to library printers via the wireless connection.

If using sound, customers are expected to use headphones so as not to disturb other customers.

Any restriction or monitoring of a minor’s access to the library’s wireless hot spot is the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian.

Tulsa City-County Library assumes no responsibility for the safety of equipment or for compromise of device configurations, security, or data files resulting from connection to the Library’s wireless access.

TCCL’s “Internet Usage and Safety Policy” is incorporated into this policy and is applicable to wi-fi users at the Library.
