American Indian Festival of Words Circle of Honor Ceremony

Honoring Neal Mc Caleb

Saturday, March 1

The Tulsa City-County Library will induct Neal Mc Caleb into the Circle of Honor. The ceremony recognizes an American Indian for his/her achievements and contributions that have enriched others' lives.

Mc Caleb is the former head of the Bureau of Indian Affairs in Washington. He has twice led the Oklahoma transportation system. While transportation secretary and director of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority, he helped develop plans for the Kilpatrick Turnpike in Oklahoma City and the Creek Turnpike in Tulsa.

Since leaving the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Mc Caleb has worked to assist the Chickasaw Nation with the development of long-term economic strategies. He also served as an elected official in the House of Representatives, where he served four years as the Republican floor leader.
