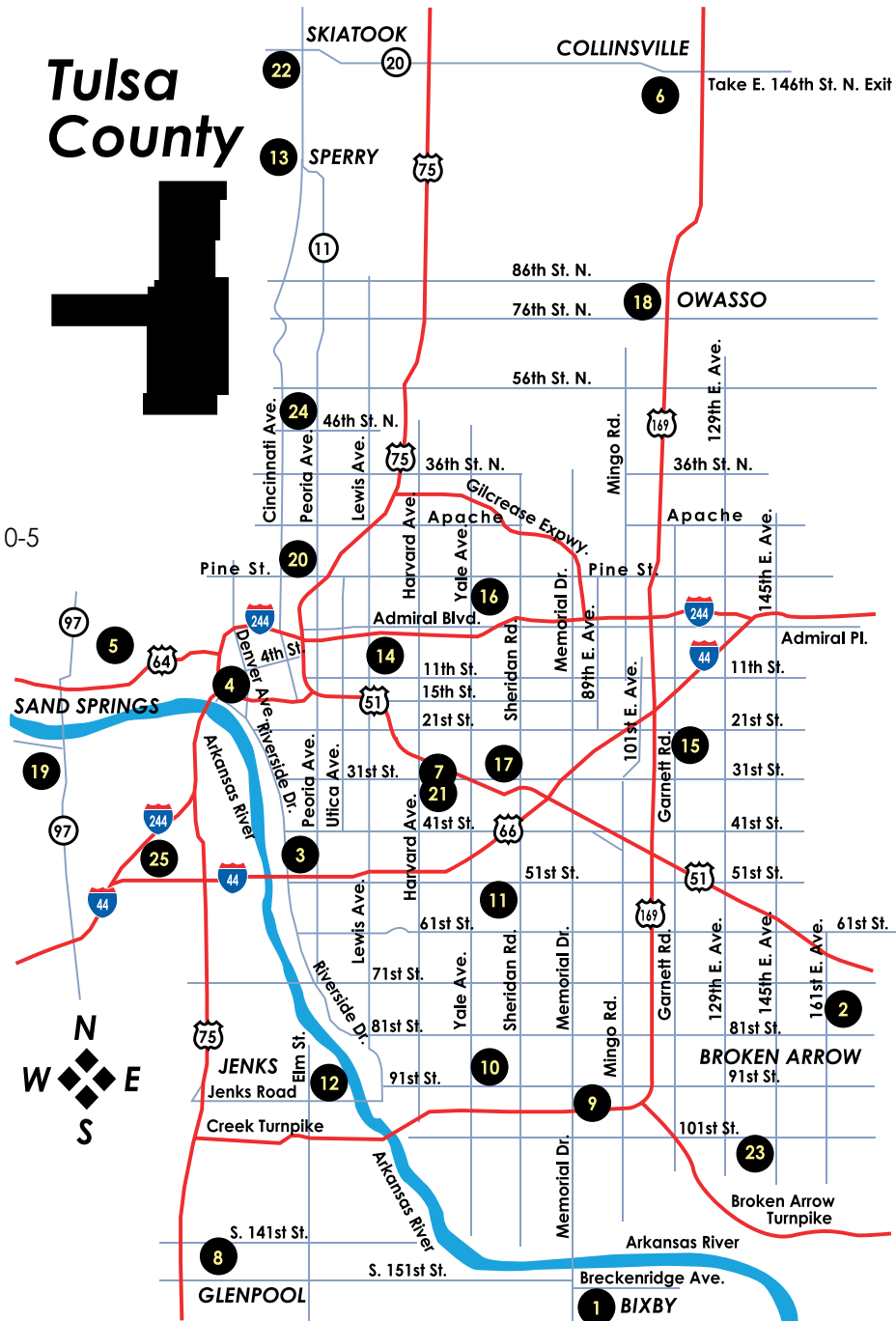

Your child heard stories from some of these books today.

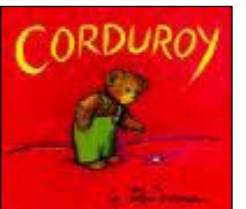

When Mom or Dad asks what you did today, you can tell them the Reading Roadshow came to read and play!

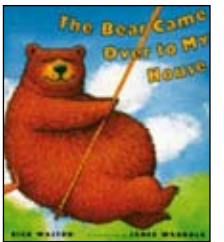
**"Corduroy" by Don Freeman**

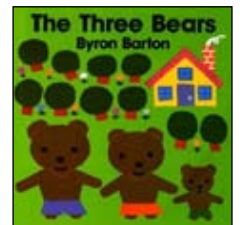
**"Bear Wants More" by Karma Wilson**

(Put thumb inside fingers.)

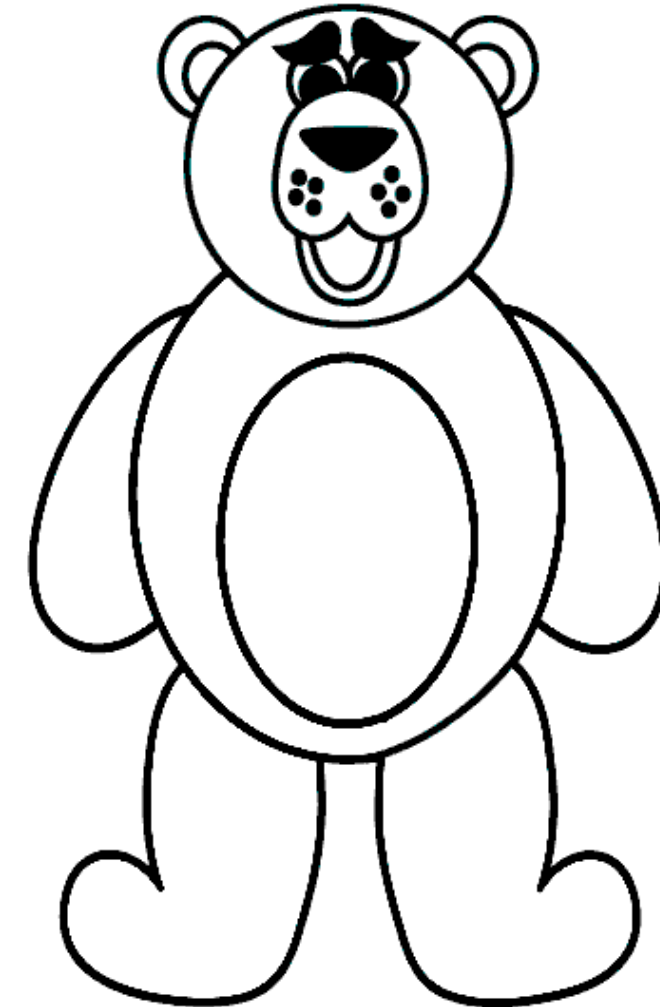
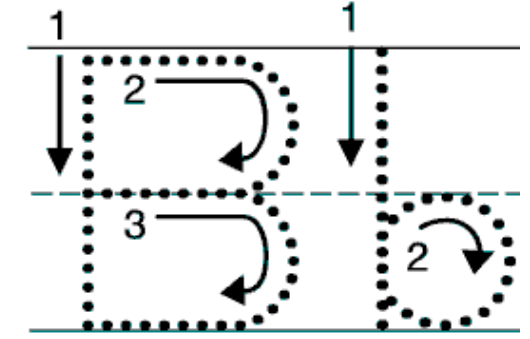
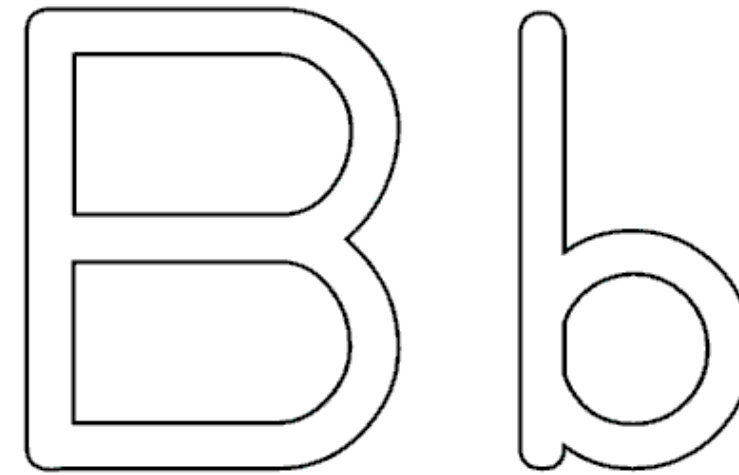
Snow covers the cave
