- Thomas Built Bus Rear – Engine, Transit Style Body & Chassis
- Model Year 2000
- Overall Length - 31 ft. 11 in.
- Overall height - 12 ft. 5 inches
- Cummins 250 HP Engine
- Air brakes, interior wheelchair lift, and front and rear passenger side door
- 20 stops per week, 25 total locations served regularly
- Fuel cost per year - \$4,000
- Number of miles travelled each month - 500
- Floor to ceiling (interior headroom) – 7 feet
- Shelving capacity on vehicle - 3,750 items
