

# Playing CDs & DVDs

Library computers feature a combination CD-playback/record and DVD-playback drive. Each drive is capable of playing back both CD (music) and DVD (video) formats. **Please note: CDs & DVDs requiring special software installs will not play on library computers.** To play your CD or DVD disc, please follow the instructions below:

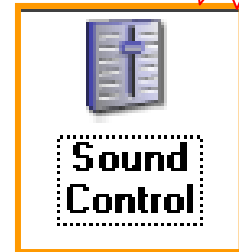
1. Insert your music or video disc (See 'Using the CD/DVD Drives' tip sheet for instructions on how to load your discs).
2. Choose the appropriate software for playing your music or video disc:

Allow 90 seconds after loading to access disc

3. If the volume from your disc playback is too low and adjusting the volume in the player does not help, minimize the player and double-click the system volume control. Adjust the computer sound control as necessary. The sound control program is found on the initial program screen.



**Computer (Master) Volume**

Once a DVD is playing, the display switches to full screen. Moving the mouse restores the DVD playback controls. While you are playing your disc, you have several control options available via the specific control buttons for DVD and CD playback:

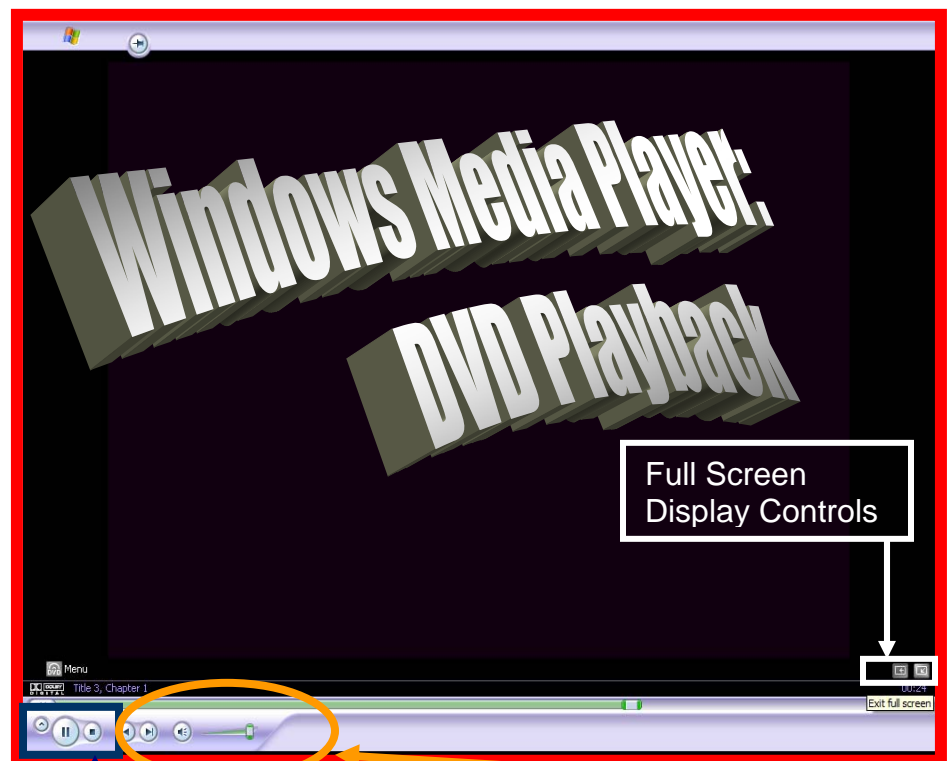
