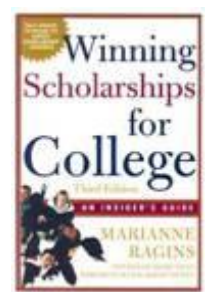
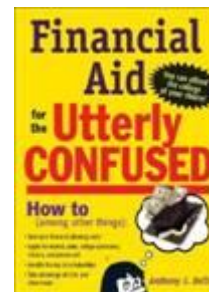
### Free Application For Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Workshop @ Martin Regional Library

Making sense of all the financial aid options available to you can be a daunting task. Never fear, the library is here! Use our resources to help understand the different types of aid, and how to get the money you need to make attending college a reality and affordable.



## Types of Financial Aid

Here is a quick overview of the many different types of financial aid available to students. It is a good idea to start by completing the Free Application For Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is a form that is required in order to receive federal student aid for college.

### Grants

A grant is a need-based form of financial aid that does not have to be repaid. Grants are typically provided by the federal government and individual states. Some examples of grants are the Federal Pell Grant, the Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants, and the Oklahoma Tuition Aid Grant.

### Loans

Loan programs are available for students to borrow money to pay for a college education. Loans must be repaid including all accrued interest and fees. Some loans are based on need and include Federal Perkins Loans and Federal Subsidized Stafford Loans. Other loans are not based on need and include Federal Unsubsidized Stafford Loans and Alternative Loans.
