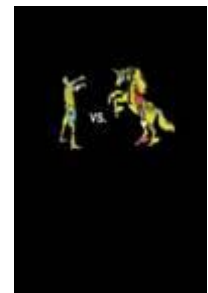
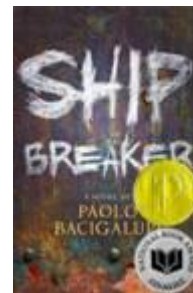
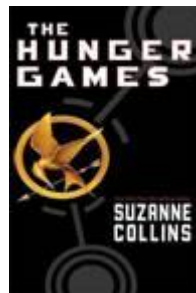
The categories include poetry, short story, informal essay, and short play. Entrants may submit **only** one manuscript per category, but they may enter all four categories within their age group.
