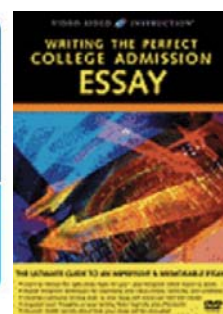
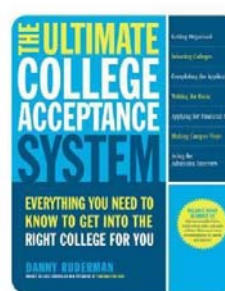
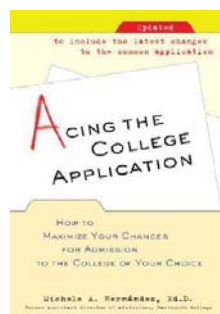
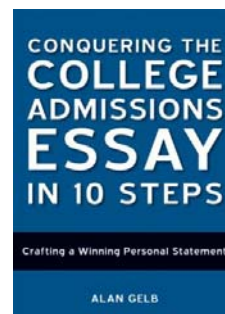
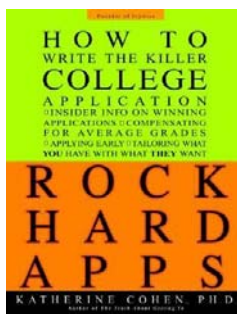
FAFSA Workshop
