## LearnATest/Learning Express

Did you know the library offers a test prep database for free? **LearnATest/Learning Express** features online interactive practice tests designed to help students succeed on academic or licensing tests. You'll get immediate scoring, complete answer explanations, and individualized analysis of your practice exam results. College entrance exams (graduate and undergraduate levels) include GED, PSAT, ACT, SAT, GRE, GMAT, and MCAT.

This database is available at all library branches or from home. There is a free one-time registration requirement for TCCL library card holders which can be done at the library or from home.

### ***How Do I Access this Database From Home?***

1. Have your library card number ready.
2. Go to [www.tulsalibrary.org](http://www.tulsalibrary.org).
3. Select "Research" from the top menu.
4. Select "Find Articles & Databases"—top icon on the left.
5. Select "Alphabetical list of all databases."
6. For **test preparation**, choose **LearnATest**.
