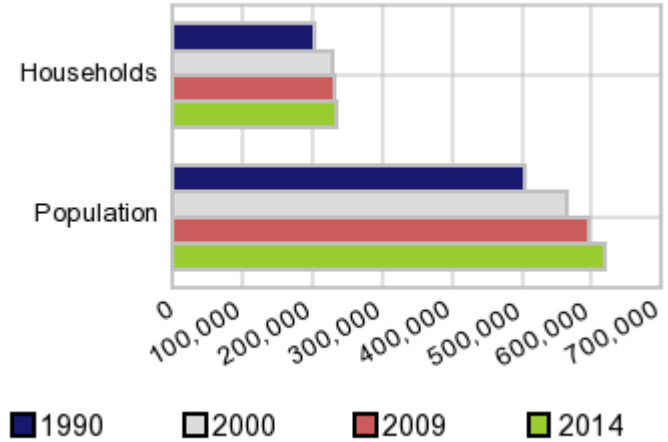
Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics

The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **202,536** and changed to **226,892** in 2000, representing a change of **12.0%**. The household count in 2009 was **231,766** and the household projection for 2014 is **232,306**, a change of **0.2%**.

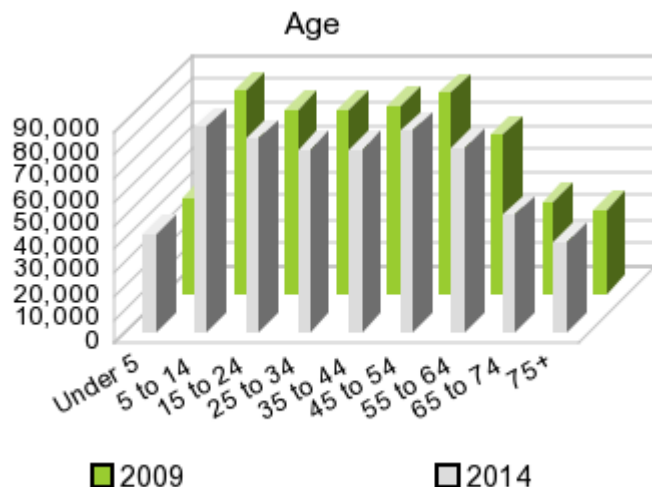
The population in the study area in 1990 was **503,346** and in 2000 it was **563,299**, roughly a **11.9%** change. The population in 2009 was **594,595** and the projection for 2014 is **618,797** representing a change of **4.1%**.

Population by Age

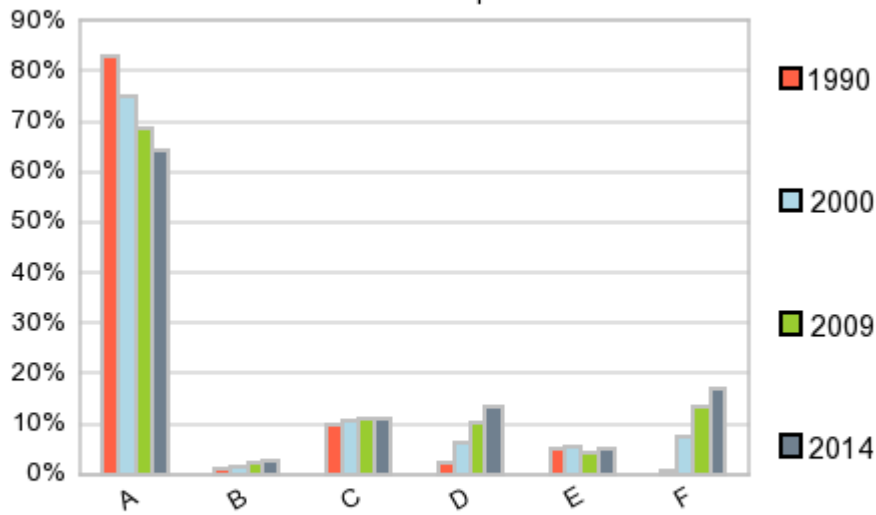


In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **32.7**, and in 2000, it was **34.4**. The median age in 2009 is **36.7** and it is predicted to change in five years to **37.6** years. In 2009, females represented **50.6%** of the population with a median age of **38.4** and males represented **49.5%** of the population with a median age of **35.0** years. In 2009, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 5 to 14** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **75 +** years.

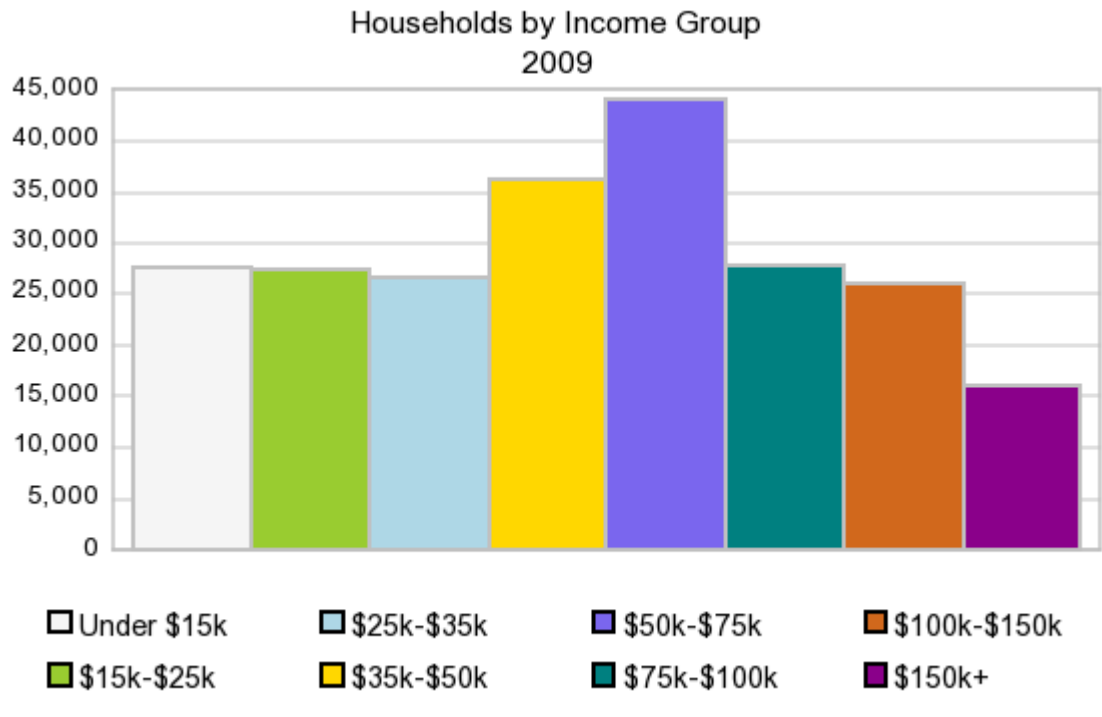

In 2009 the predominant household income category in this study area is **\$50K - \$75K**, and the income group that is least represented in this geography is **\$150K +**.

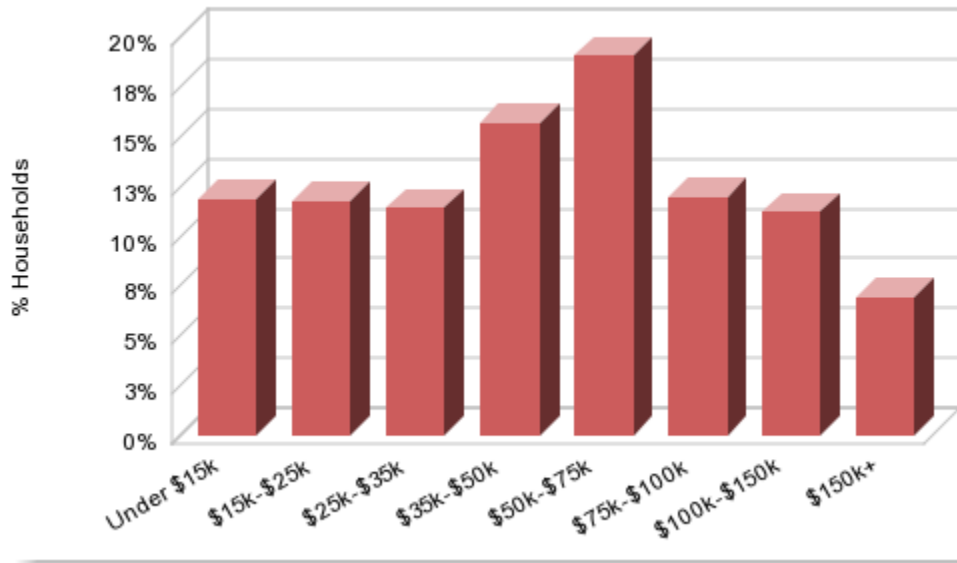

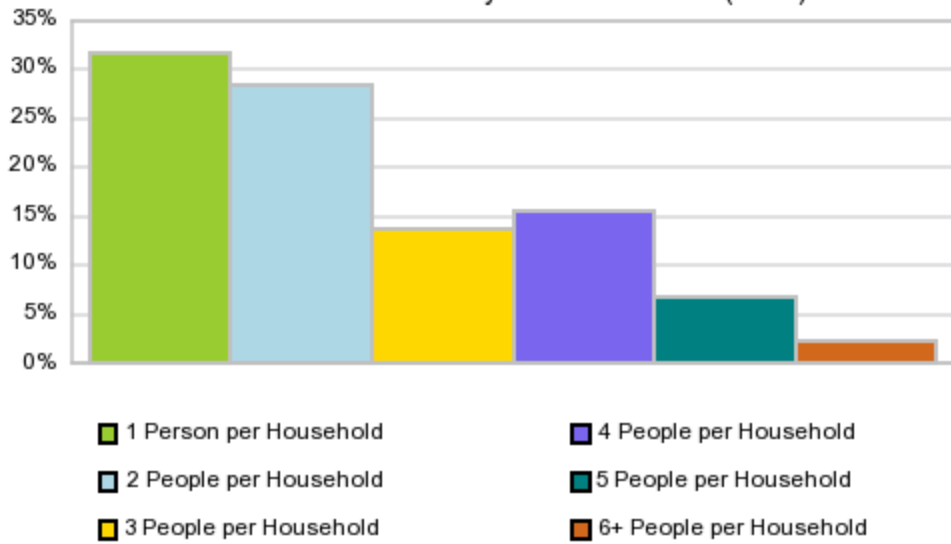

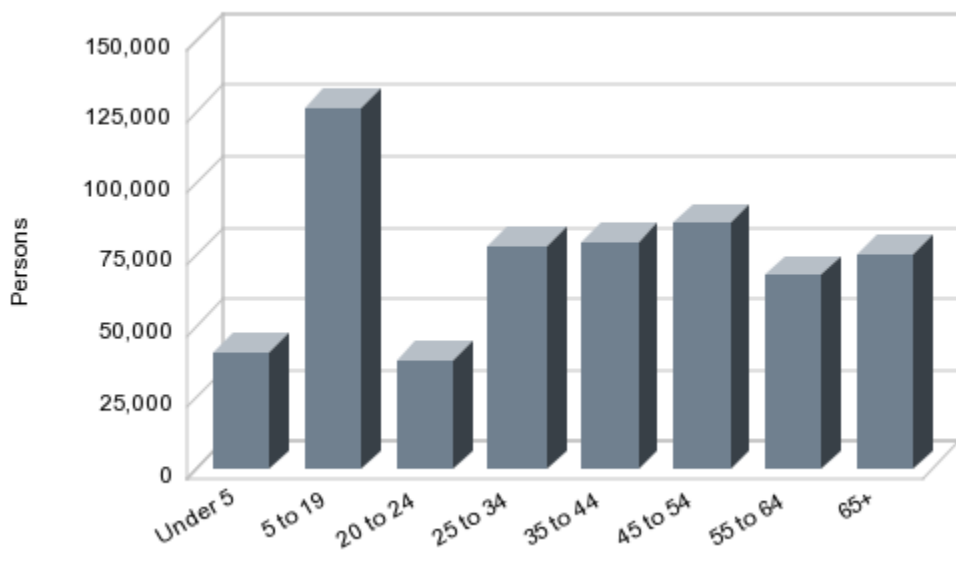
Household Income (2009)



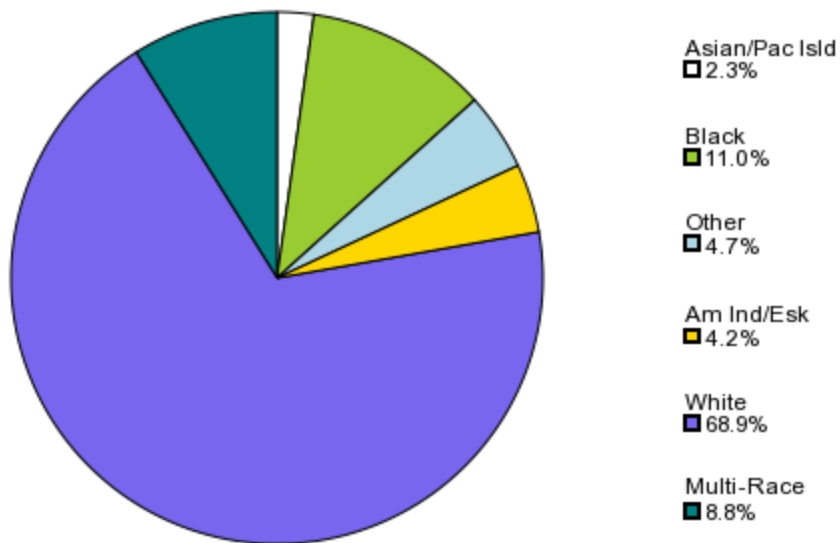
Percent of Households by Persons Per HH (2009)



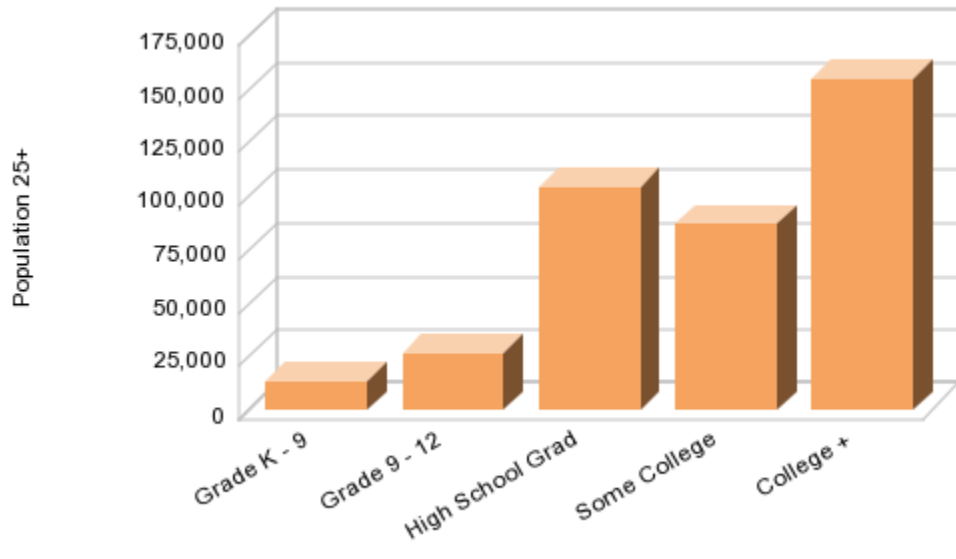
Population by Age (2009)



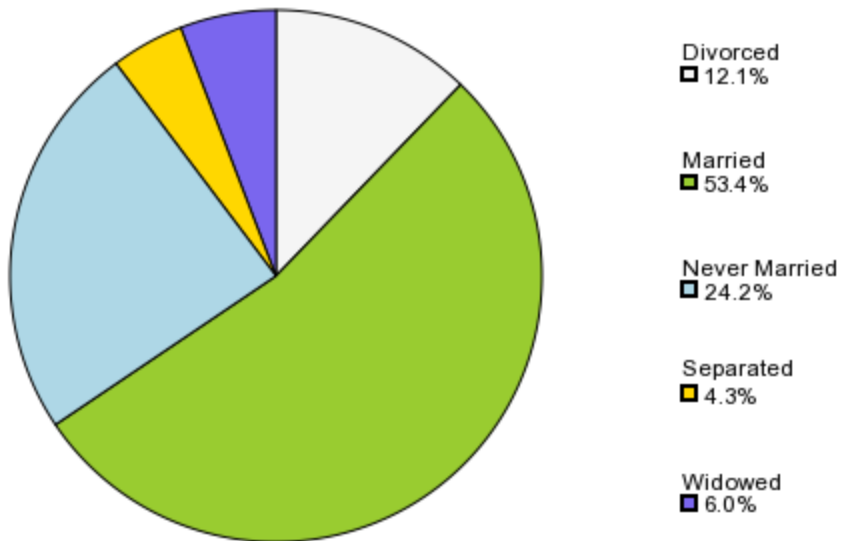
Population by Race (2009)

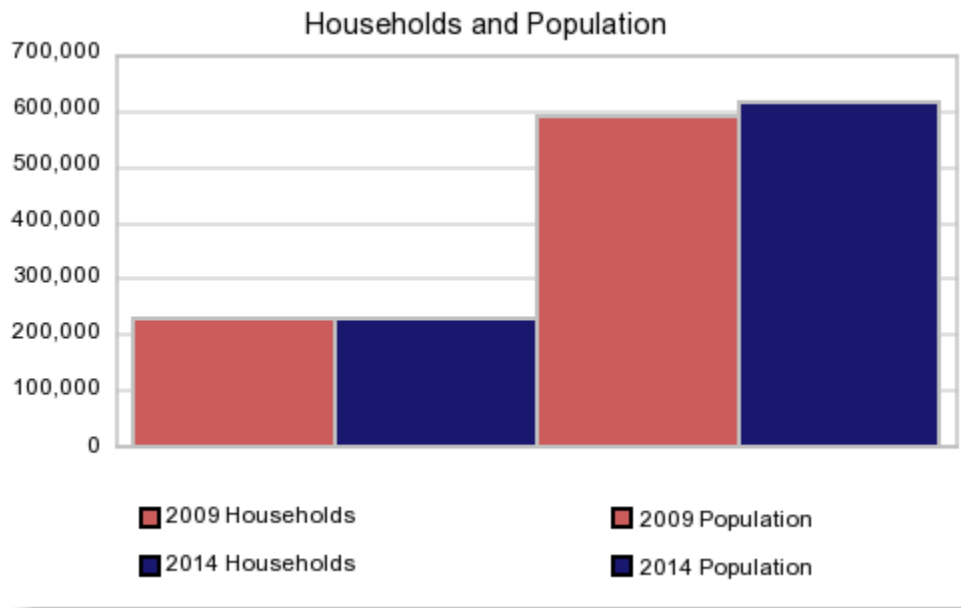


Education (2009)
