Hardesty Regional Library, 8316 E. 93rd St., will host special events to celebrate its 20th anniversary on Friday, June 30, starting at 10 a.m. The celebration will kick off in Connor's Cove Children's Theater, which is celebrating its 15th anniversary, with a live performance from Hot Toast Music Company, the product of dad, educator and musician Symon Hajjar who writes purposeful, irresistible music for kids. The Hardesty Regional Library began as the South Regional Library in 1982 at 18,300 square feet. The largest TCCL branch at the time, it was heavily used from day one. When Roger and Donna Hardesty made a generous donation in 1984, the South Regional branch was renamed in their honor. However, even after expanding the building in 1991, the space was unable to meet the needs of Tulsa's fastest growing region. In 2001, the Hardestys made another generous offer: an 8-acre site that allowed TCCL to expand the building and parking lot again, resulting in the current two-story, 50,000-square-foot library that opened in May 2003.
