and this center can really be inspiring and encouraging to students.

"As a former school teacher, I had students who'd come from very rough, very bad places and they feel powerless," McCloud said. "They feel 'well this is where my parents came from.' that's all I'm going to be,' and you know, Woody didn't have a life of privilege. [But] here's this wonderful center devoted to him and people singing his praises because of his example of writing about things that need to be changed. So just because [a person] doesn't come from a family of power or money, [it] doesn't mean that you can't change the world. It doesn't mean that you can't leave vour footprint."

The Woody Guthrie Center is located at 102 E. Brady in Tulsa and is closed on Mondays. So grab your children and your friends, and check out the inspiring center that celebrates Woody's life and the legacy.
