

Monique Sendze, chief information officer for Tulsa City-County Library, has been recognized as a top CIO in the country by the Info-Tech Research Group.

Sendze was one of nine information technology leaders recognized in the Mid-Market category. The award winners were determined through Business Vision, an IT stakeholder satisfaction survey that helps CIOs understand the needs of their key business stakeholders.

Sendze has worked in information technology management for more than seventeen years and joined the Tulsa City-County Library in 2015 as the Chief Technology and Innovation Officer. Previously she worked at the Douglas County Libraries in Colorado and the Johnson County Library in Kansas as the IT Director.



### Bridge beams moved out of Tulsa Port of Catoosa

Twenty-four concrete bridge beams were shipped to their new location on Grand River last month from the Tulsa Port of Catoosa.

The pre-stressed concrete beams were part of a new bridge being built near Fort Gibson by C-Gawf Construction. The beams were made in Tulsa by Coreslab. Each beam is 145 feet long and weighs 145,500 pounds. It took four barges to transport the beams from the Tulsa Port of Catoosa down the Verdigris River then up the Grand River to the bridge.

The beams were part of 188,995 tons of cargo handled by the port in June.

The McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System handled 979,684 tons during June. The Oklahoma segment of the waterway handled 52 percent of the tonnage, including the port's 19 percent.
