Attorney Scott Eudey is the new Ward 4 Broken Arrow City Councilor.

Eudey defeated incumbent Jill Norman, 1,484-862, and garnered 63.26 percent of the votes cast on Tuesday.

Eudey led 70-62 only before Tuesday's voting began.

About 8:30 p.m., Broken Arrow Mayor Craig Thurmond acknowledged that it was obvious Eudey had won the election and introduced him as "Broken Arrow's next councilman." Eudey thanked everyone
