

The adult learning guide features Universal Class on the right hand side. Just sign in, choose your class or classes, and start learning

Some of the subject areas include: home and garden, office skills, homeschooling, crafts and hobbies, career training, finance, art and photography, business, and alternative medicine.

Some Universal Class descriptions:

Couponing 101

You can save thousands of dollars by using coupons found in magazines, online, and in newspapers for everyday items. This course explains how to find and use coupons, how to organize your coupons, and online v. in-store shopping. Learn the ins and outs of couponing as well as tried and true ways of
