Gary Wayne Harding gathers more awards

Gary Wayne Harding has gathered two more awards to bring positive recognition to both him and the Collinsville High School program directed by his father, Weston Harding. Gary recently received the Jim Thorpe Player of the Year Award for Wrestling. The awards banquet was held on June 5th at the Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame in Oklahoma City.

Gary Wayne also recently received the Dave Schultz High School Excellence Award for the State of Oklahoma.

The National Wrestling Hall of Fame announced May 7th its state and regional winners for the 2014 Dave Schultz and Patricia Saunders High School Excellence Awards, with four Oklahoma State signees receiving the honor.

Originally created in honor of Schultz, an Olympic and World champion, the High School Excellence Award is based on excellence in wrestling, scholastic achievement, citizenship and community service.

Multi-colored fish, shaped with individual pieces of tile, greet children entering the ocean-themed storytime room. 
