From 1964-75, she taught at the University of Toronto, where she was also Vice

President, before going to Smith College. Since 1985, she has been a visiting scholar and professor in MIT's program in Science, Technology and Society. She serves on the boards of Nike, Merrill Lynch and Colgate-Palmolive, and as Chairman of Lend Lease Corporation. She lives in Boston.

Proceeds from the fundraiser will support P.E.O projects and philanthropies, including grants and scholarships for women pursuing educational opportunities.

The dramatization will be held at 6:30-8 p.m. at 301 S. Cedar St.
