District court receives training grant

A two-year grant to fund Court Training and Improvements has been awarded to the Tulsa County District Court.

The \$300,000 grant will focus on developing effective responses to violence against women.

Kelly Greenough has been named project director.

Greenough, who has a wide array of experience in both the public and private sectors, currently is employed in the Civil Division of the Tulsa County Public Defender's Office.

Approximately 1,600 domestic assault and battery charges (7 percent of all criminal charges) were filed last

year in Tulsa County.

Domestic assault and battery is ranked 3rd as the most often filed criminal charge.

Additionally, 4,000 requests for protective orders were filed.

The Court's goal is to improve court responses to victims of sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence and stalking. «
