After losing their mother Patti rather suddenly to Pancreatic Cancer, sisters Chrissy Harrison, of Glenpool, and Shauna Stewart, of Sand Springs, have made it their life's mission to aid the Pancreatic Cancer Action Network (PanCan) so that it may do for Pancreatic Cancer Research what the Susan G. Komen Foundation has done for Breast Cancer Research.

Harrison said Patti went to the hospital Dec. 18, 2011 complaining of back pain. On Dec. 23, 2011 a CT scan revealed Patti had Pancreatic Cancer. Patti died March 9, 2012, only three days after her 49th birthday and only 77 days after being d agnosed.
