These Fines assume that materials are returned undamaged. Full replacement costs are assessed for damaged materials. See Appendix section 'Replacement Charges for Lost or Damaged Materials' for details.

Restrictions/Criteria

Customers will be prevented from checking out materials, renewing or requesting items if fines are \$25 or more. If fines are \$50 or more, computer usage privileges are removed.

The highest level overdue at which customers are blocked is a bill. That is one item, 45 days past due.

Collections Agency

The library will send customer records to a collection agency when unpaid fines and fees reach \$50 or more and there is at least one billed item on the record.

If a customer account is referred to a collection agency, a \$10 recovery fee will be assessed in addition to any accrued fines or fees. This \$10 fee may not waived even if materials are returned.

Children's/Juvenile Material Fines

These materials will not accumulate fines no matter who checks them out. This does NOT include replacement fees for lost, long overdue, or damaged materials.
