



PASS Objectives:

- 2.1 Identify basic landforms and bodies of water (e.g., plains, mountains, rivers, and gulfs), the four oceans, the seven continents, human-made features (e.g., roads and towns).

Focus: The students will determine the continents where the habitats pictured in [I See a Kookaburra!](#) are located.

Activities: Using a world map, students will locate and label the habitats, countries, and continents used in I See a Kookaburra!

Science Lesson Plan

Pass Objectives:

- 2.1 Classify a set of simple objects, familiar organisms, and/or observable events by observable properties.

Focus: The students will create a local habitat.

Activities:

- Through observation or research, determine local animals and insects that might be found in a local habitat.
- Create a classroom wall mural showing the animals found in the local habitat. Use a variety of types of paper to create a collage of the habitat.
