1. ***Past Tense*** by Lee Child. Jack Reacher explores the New England town where his father was born and a Canadian couple now find themselves stranded.
2. ***Nine Perfect Strangers*** by Liane Moriarty. A romance writer becomes fascinated by the owner and director of a health resort.
3. ***The Reckoning*** by John Grisham. A decorated World War II veteran shoots and kills a pastor inside a Mississippi church.
4. ***Dark Sacred Night*** by Michael Connelly. Detective Renee Ballard teams up with the retired detective Harry Bosch, who is working on a cold case.
5. ***Every Breath*** by Nicholas Sparks. Difficult choices surface when Hope Anderson and Tru Walls meet in a North Carolina seaside town.
6. ***Elevation*** by Stephen King. A man who is losing weight without getting thinner forms an unlikely alliance with his neighbors who are dealing with prejudices.
7. ***The Next Person You Meet in Heaven*** by Mitch Albom. The sequel to “The Five People You Meet in Heaven” follows Annie on her heavenly journey.
8. ***Unsheltered*** by Barbara Kingsolver. Intertwined stories of two families who live in different centuries on the same street corner in Vineland, N.J.
9. ***The Noel Stranger*** by Richard Paul Evans. A newly divorced woman develops a friendship with the owner of a Christmas tree lot.
10. ***Sea of Greed*** by Clive Cussler and Graham Brown. The 16th book in the NUMA Files series.

Non-Fiction

1. ***Killing the SS*** by Bill O’Reilly and Martin Dugard. A look at the postwar manhunt for members of Hitler’s inner circle.
2. ***Beastie Boys Book*** by Michael Diamond and Adam Horowitz. The story of the New York band who went from performing hardcore punk music to hip hop stardom.
3. ***Ship of Fools*** by Tucker Carlson. The Fox News anchor argues that America’s ruling class is out of touch with everyday citizens.
4. ***Leadership*** by Doris Kearns Goodwin. The challenges that shaped the leadership abilities of four presidents: Abraham Lincoln, Theodore Roosevelt, Franklin D. Roosevelt, and Lyndon B. Johnson.
