## Here are some IDEAS for what YOU CAN DO to help get your child READY FOR READING!

<b>TALK:</b> ✓ Go on a walk in your neighborhood and talk about all the sounds you hear. ✓ Tell your child about a childhood pet of yours. ✓ Let your child use a flashlight in a dark room and talk about what you see.
SING: ✓ Sing the alphabet together and clap your hands to the beat. ✓ Put beans or rice inside an oatmeal container and tape shut. Shake your new shaker to the beat of a favorite song! ✓ Play music and move to the beat. Occasionally stop the music and freeze.
<b>READ:</b> ✓ Pick a letter and look for that letter around the room. ✓ Reread a favorite book. Leave out some words to see if your child can say them. ✓ Read a book and talk about the parts of the book: cover, title page, back, etc.
<b>WRITE:</b> ✓ Fill a cookie sheet with salt or sand and practice writing your initials. ✓ Make a grocery list togethe ✓ Draw a picture and give it to someone you love!
<b>PLAY:</b> Crumple some paper balls and play a toss game into a basket. Have an imaginary birthday party for a stuffed animal. Pretend to be a dinosaur and stomp around the room!
