

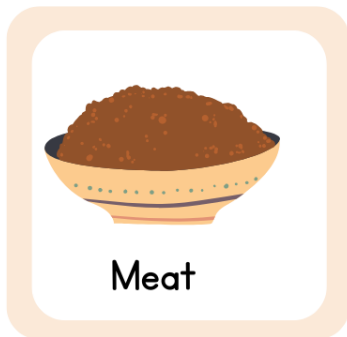
## Books to Treasure “¡Vamos! Let’s Go Cook”

- **Books Needed:** [¡Vamos! Let’s Go Eat](#) by Raúl the Third
- It’s time to eat! Let’s make a burrito, but wait! How do we do that? Let’s practice our sequence of events and recipe skills to make a delicious lunch. What should we start with???
- **Do This!**
  - Read ¡Vamos! Let’s Go Eat by Raúl the Third.
    - Ask if anyone has been to a food truck before, what they like to eat, and how they think they could create that meal themselves. Get them thinking of recipes and sequence of events like when making a peanut butter and jelly sandwich, do you start with the peanut butter, the jelly, or the bread?!
  - Practice on the board with a recipe, maybe a peanut butter sandwich, so they know what to expect when it’s their turn.
  - Complete the printable and share out ideas.
    - Ask, why is there not a #1 next to the meat? Why is #5 the boy eating the burrito and not X? Etc.
  - Extend this activity into an art project, and have them create their own design for a food truck. What would they call it and what would they sell?
